
The Transparency Paradox

We can't solve problems we can't see & we can't collaborate with people we don't know exist. We need to see which organizations are connected to build solutions together.




What does it mean?

It means your company will appear in our open global database of production locations used by brands, retailers, service providers, and other organizations to disclose suppliers and identify new partners.

Once added, your location will receive a free and universal ID (OS ID).







To unite and support all stakeholders by developing and deploying a Converged Assessment Framework (CAF) that delivers harmonized, accessible and trusted data.





What is SLCP?

SLCP is a multi-stakeholder initiative that:



Implements the Converged Assessment Framework (CAF) to collect & verify social compliance data.




SLCP verified data is owned by the facility and can be shared with all business partners.



Replaces the need for repetitive audits and frees up resources for improvement programs.




Provides credible data that supports end-users to meet due diligence requirements.







The CAF is used to complete the SLCP assessment process

The Converged Assessment Framework (CAF) is suitable for use in most factory settings as the questions and data are:

- Globally applicable
- Comprehensive
- Aligned with OECD
- Aligned with ILO conventions and national labor law

The CAF has been used in diverse sectors including apparel, distribution centers, hard goods, and home furnishings.



SLCP and OS Hub: How we work together



Our shared goal: Reducing data duplication & finding collaborative solutions to ease Human Rights Due Diligence (HRDD) burdens.

- To make HRDD effective, we believe in solutions that:
 - Encourage collaboration
 - Prioritize the needs of suppliers
- Over 8000 active SLCP facilities are matched to OS IDs and listed on <u>Open Supply Hub</u>.
 - This means that if someone needs details about a facility who has an SLCP assessment, they can look them up on Open Supply Hub using their OS ID



SLCP and OS Hub: Why should you get an OS ID?

- It's easier for buyers to find you and request access to your SLCP data
- You may receive fewer audit requests and more data sharing requests
- Save time, money and resources
- Helps suppliers implement effective HRDD in practice
- OS Hub ensures consistent identification across platforms

SLCP and OS Hub: Example

Cut & sew facility in Türkiye

- Facility is overloaded with audit and information requests
- Major buyer informs them they accept SLCP assessments
- The facility adds an OS ID to their gateway profile
- The profile can be shared with multiple customers, letting buyers request already existing, reliable HRDD data directly instead of asking for repetitive audits or surveys



By shifting from one-off assessments to SLCP's and OS Hub's shared, reusable data model, the facility:

- reduced audit fatigue
- freed up staff time for improvements
- provided brands with faster access to accurate information

Transforms HRDD from reactive compliance into proactive transparency




