# We link the data. We don't lock it down.

## WHAT SPOTLIGHT IS

### A link between datasets.

Pointing users to where the data they need actually lives:  
anchored to the OS ID, in context, ready to act on.

## WHAT IT'S NOT

### A new data silo.

Spotlight does not host our partners' data, unless they want us to. Our partners keep their authority over their data and their relationships.



# Built for the whole ecosystem.

## BRANDS & RETAILERS

- ✦ A clean, standardized supplier dataset with a single OS ID anchoring each production location across every tool and partner you work with
- ✦ Access to updated records that support your supply chain due diligence efforts as part of a broader compliance program
- ✦ Supply chain mapping with visibility into who else is connected to your suppliers - surfacing opportunities for collaboration

## SERVICE PROVIDERS

- ✦ Interoperability and simplified data exchange across platforms through a shared production location identifier (the OS ID)
- ✦ Deliver more value and unlock richer capabilities for your own customers
- ✦ A "single source of truth" data foundation through an ongoing connection to the OS Hub database

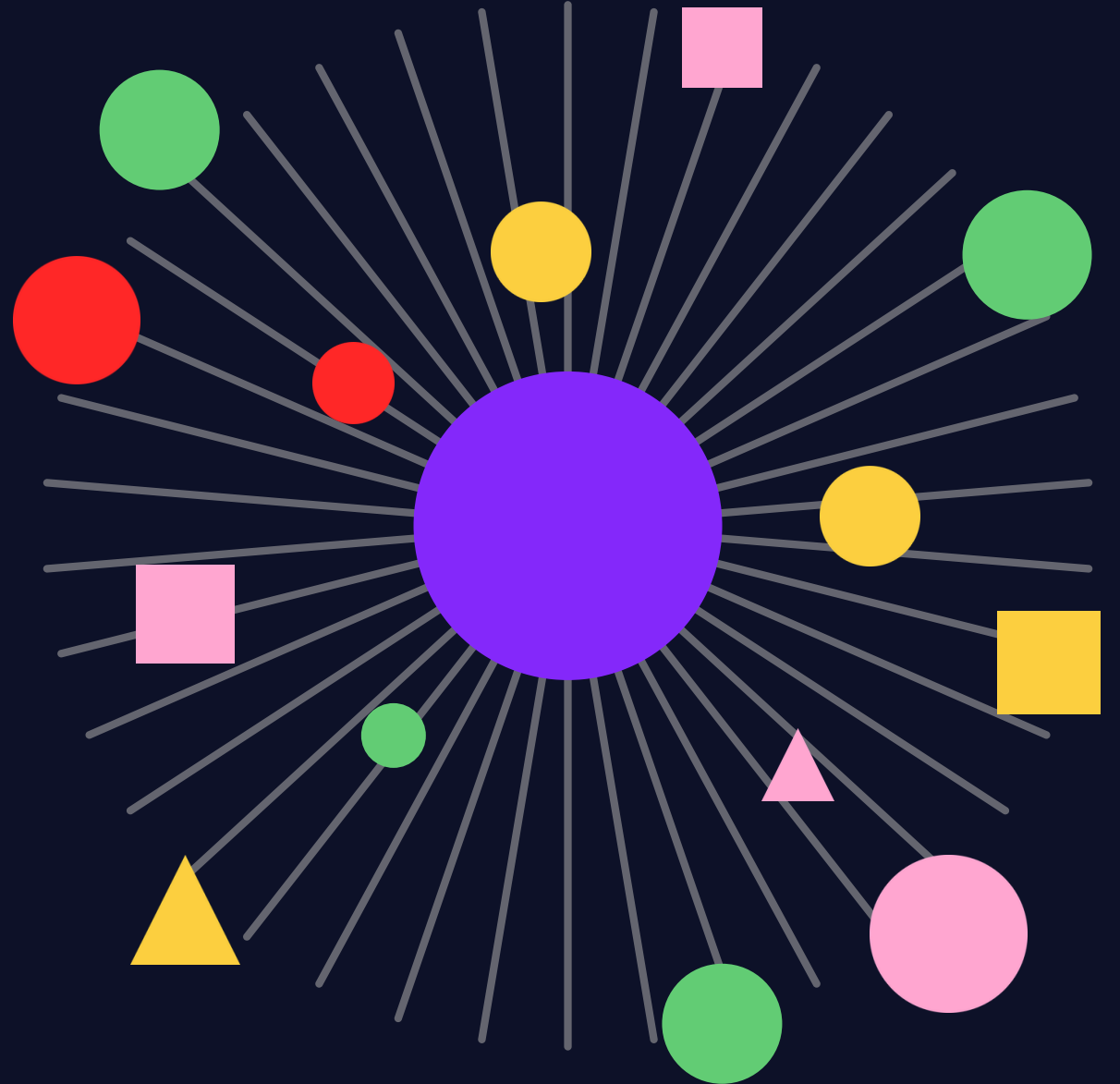

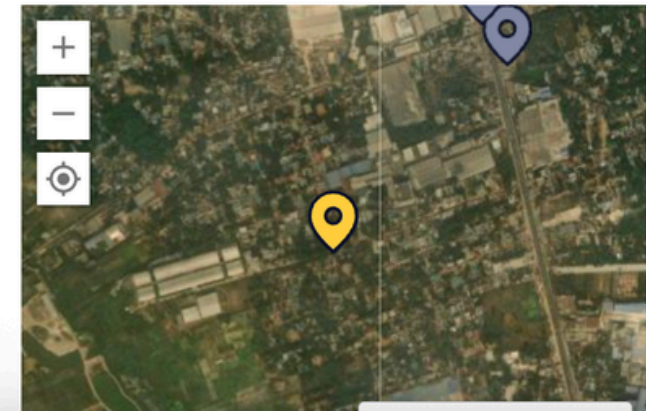

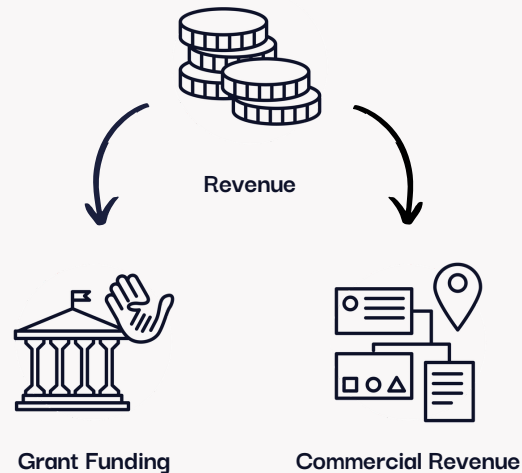

### Data Downloads & Analysis

A CSV or Excel file download of data available in OS Hub. Available in increments of 10,000 production locations and/or in bulk via a Custom Data Download for those looking to acquire large portions of the dataset.



### API Connection

An integration providing ongoing access to the OS Hub database to pull in all available data at the production location level. Six API package tiers designed to scale with you as your usage grows.

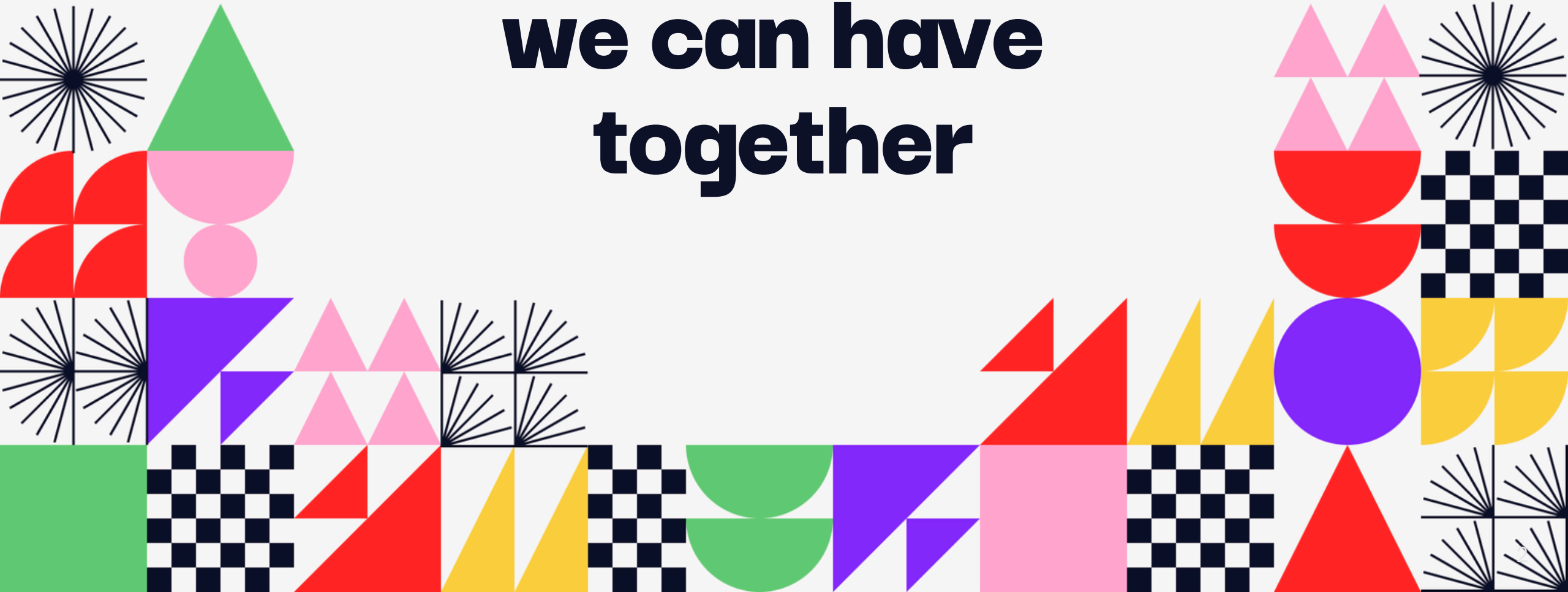

# Interoperable Infrastructure for Supply Chain Accountability



Supply chain governance is increasingly structured through **digital infrastructure**.

As highlighted in the 'Beyond Transparency report', those **most affected by supply chain harms are often excluded from these digital systems**.

Spotlight represents one step towards addressing this challenge by building open, shared public infrastructure where **diverse actors** – from worker rights organizations to environmental initiatives – can **connect and contribute data** in relation to production locations across global supply chains.



# Spotlight helps make supply chain data more connected, accessible, and useful for stakeholders across the supply chain.



**Workers** can identify the different grievance mechanisms available at a facility, from brand-operated systems to union-led support pathways



**Researchers** can connect climate and labor rights data to better understand overlapping risks at the facility level



**Suppliers and brands** can identify where multiple assessments, certifications, or accountability systems already exist, helping reduce duplication, improve coordination, & strengthen due diligence.



**Policymakers and regulators** can use the data to better understand overlapping labor, environmental, and due diligence risks across sectors and regions, helping inform more targeted oversight, remediation efforts, and policy interventions.

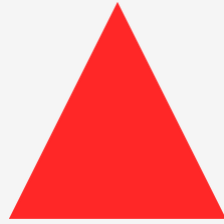


# Supporting Trade Union & Civil Society Participation

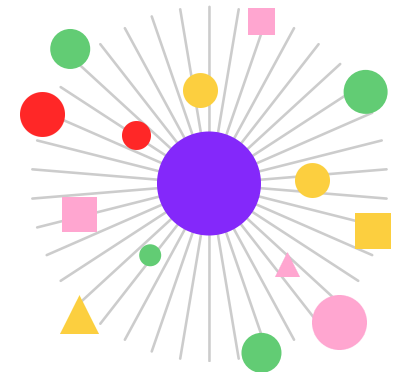
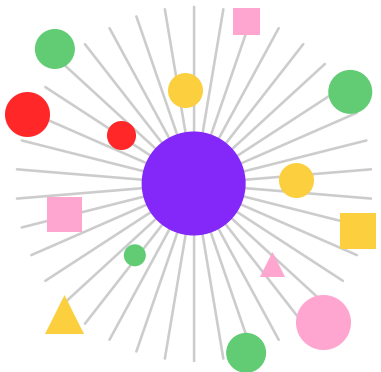
